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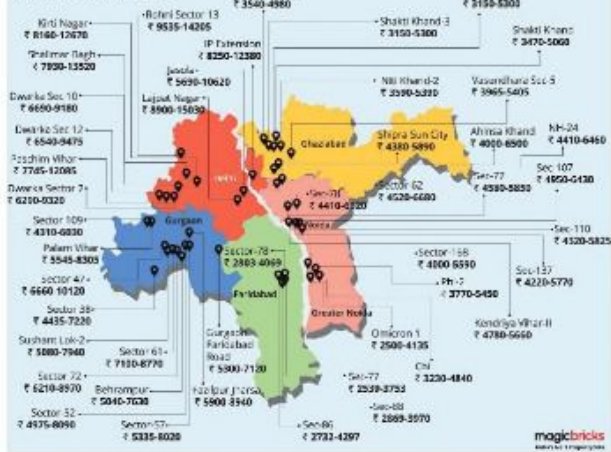

A national highway helps a region thrive, in terms of real estate development. The widening of NH-24 and completion of Phase 1 of Delhi-Meerut Expressway will significantly benefit the multiple micro-pockets of Ghaziabad and Noida

Phase 1 of Delhi-Meerut Expressway, the 18 km stretch from Nizamuddin Bridge in Delhi to the UP border, has been completed in a record 18 months at a cost of Rs 811 crore. It includes a 6-lane expressway and 4 plus-4 service lanes, that is a 14-lane facility from Nizamuddin Bridge to the UP border. It has several features that help reduce pollution in the area. This expressway is a blessing for commuters, as it is an essential route through which thousands of people travel from Delhi to Ghaziabad, Noida and other nearby places daily. It is also important for commercial growth, as residents have can easily commute from one place to another for their daily needs. (Raj Nagar Extension, Indraprastha, Siddhartha Vihar, Crossing Republic, etc. which have direct connectivity with NH 24, will be the first to reap the benefits of this

expected that several projects located near this stretch on NH-24 will pick up demand and this may push commercial activities in the area. "With the current trend in the realty market shifting more towards affordable housing, the widening of this highway will certainly open multiple new pockets for development as a major issue of connectivity would have been addressed," Manoj Gaur, vice-president of Credai National, said. "These new pockets will emerge as affordable housing destinations due to their low cost. Once an area starts populating, commercial real estate automatically picks up to fulfil the demand from residents," Gaur said. Once the whole expressway becomes operational, growth of the localities along the whole stretch will be on a fast track and demand will go up. Ghaziabad will benefit from this because of the ripple effect which this development will have on regions adjoining the micro pockets falling directly on this expressway. "Micro pockets like Indraprastha and the Phase 1 of Crossing Republic have already developed to a large extent, but Siddhartha Vihar and Phase 2 of Crossing Republic are still budding. Siddhartha Vihar has huge housing potential and more than 2 lakh people are expected to live there in the next 5 years," Gaurav Gupta, general secretary of Credai Ghaziabad, said. Enhancement of connectivity around the Delhi NCR is not only going to help the real estate sector but also make the lives of commuters easy. Opening of Phase 1 of Delhi-Meerut Expressway will decongest the area and reduce travel time significantly.
