

Noida asks NHAI to build road parallel to Noida expressway

NOIDA: The Noida authority has asked the National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) to build a 32km elevated road above the Yamuna embankment road from Noida's Sector 94 to the Noida-Greater Noida border to decongest the Noida-Greater Noida Expressway, officials aware of the matter said on Sunday.

The Noida authority's chief executive officer, Lokesh M, met

NHAI chairman Santosh Yadav three months ago and requested him to build this elevated road. Now, the authority has prepared a project report about the road and sent it to NHAI, officials added.

"We sent the report to NHAI after site inspection and a detailed analysis of the current and estimated future traffic influx on the Noida expressway. NHAI will carry out a survey and prepare a detailed project report of this project. This road is needed because of the

expected increase in traffic volume due to the Noida airport becoming operational this year. Once the road is built, it will be connected with the under construction 5.5km Chilla elevated road," said Lokesh M. This road will also be connected with the Yamuma Expressway to provide seamless connectivity with the Noida airport at Jewar, officials added.

In a related development, the Noida authority has decided to widen the Delhi-Noida Link Road, said Lokesh M.
